This student is hoping to attain the Arkansas High School diploma by taking the Tests of General Educational Development (GED), but will need special accommodations in order to pass the examination. A psychological or neuropsychological evaluation is required in order for the student to receive appropriate accommodations as specified by the American Council on Education and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Enclosed is a form entitled, "Request for Special Accommodation in GED Test Administration" which requires that a certifying professional specify the disability of the GED candidate and recommended accommodations. We have included some information to assist you in explaining what interventions have been attempted and with what results.

The following accommodations have been successful in working with the individual:

- ___ extended time for tests
- ___ frequent breaks
- ___ isolated space or private room for work
- ___ large-print version of text and/or answer sheet
- ___ use of calculator or computerized spell check
- ___ written text read aloud and/or audio cassette version
- ___ computer-aided instruction
- ___ scribe
