In the programs' **inaugural year**, we seek individuals who can serve 900 hours from **October 5, 2020 – July 31, 2021** as an Adult Education AmeriCorps Life Coach.

AmeriCorps is a **national service program** that engages 80,000 individuals of all ages and backgrounds annually in service to their communities and America.

1. **Getting Things Done** – a chance to make your mark on a specific community need
2. **Strengthening Communities** – making the communities and organizations where you serve stronger
3. **Encouraging Responsibility** – developing leaders that continue service to community and civic life

Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years or older when applying
- Must have obtained a high school diploma, GED or Associates Degree from an accredited university
- Willingness to meet service hour requirement outlined above
- Knowledgeable of the adult education mission
- Ability to meet and build relationships with diverse groups
- Ability to participate and speak at community events as a representative of the adult education program and AmeriCorps.
- Maintain a flexible service schedule
- Must have access to transportation
- Must be highly motivated and able to work with minimal direct supervision
- Must have excellent interpersonal and organizational skills
- Ability to communicate effectively orally, in writing and in public presentation settings

Benefits:

- Monthly living allowance of \$675.00
- Education award of \$3,097.50 to repay qualified student loans and pay certain education costs at qualified institutions
- Student loan deferment
- Access to professional training and development opportunities
