Clarence Childs, Yulanda Riley, and William Hunter, Program Advisors with the state Adult Education office, will present. This training will overlap with the SNAP E & T Program Coordinator training. On Wednesday, October 27, both TANF Providers and SNAP E & T Coordinators, will participate in a joint training session. For those attending in-person, room reservations can be made directly with the hotel.

This training will cover topics related specifically to TANF providers and their programs. Topics will include creating partnerships, acquiring and utilizing resources, and understanding and applying policy.

Adult education funded participants will be reimbursed according to state travel guidelines. Please remember that according to Adult Education policy, only one car per 4 participants can receive mileage reimbursement unless prior written permission from Dr. Trenia Miles, Director, Division of Workforce Services, Adult Education Section, has been obtained. Participants **must live or work (whichever is closer) 150 miles or more from Little Rock** in order to receive reimbursement for lodging for the night before. Total maximum lodging reimbursement per night is \$96 + tax. Participants must submit an original hotel bill.
