These self-paced/online workshops are being offered quarterly with the exception of the June 2023 course. All courses are the same course, so please only register for one. Participants may contact Michael Judge, state Distance Learning Liaison, if you have questions or issues logging into the Canvas course.

These courses focus on teaching the fundamentals of using Canvas; the state's official Learning Management System (LMS) for Adult Education. In this workshop, participants will explore how to: customize account notifications; personalize the canvas dashboard and course list; leverage the canvas calendar, announcements and conversations; set up a course homepage, modules and custom course navigation; use student view, the canvas speed grader, and rubrics. Participants must attain an 80% or higher score on the final Canvas assessment in order to earn the completion certificate.
