## Basic Fundamentals in Excel (AALRC) Session ID: 533914

This training is scheduled for Thursday, November 14, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. at the AALRC. Attendees may valet park in the building parking deck and the AALRC will validate. Excel is a spreadsheet software program and comes as part of the Microsoft Office Suite. This software allows users to create and navigate spreadsheets and the data within them. This workshop will provide users with a basic understanding of Excel with the core functions and the logic behind Excel formulas. Users will gain knowledge on inputting data, organizing the data, and calculating the data with functions and formulas. These skills help users to:

- Navigate: Data is analyzed and organized to navigate company goals and confirm strategic plans
- Calculate: Data is calculated to determine whether company budgets are being respected
- Record: Data is recorded and inputted for company records

Adult education funded participants will be reimbursed according to state travel guidelines (refer to Program Memo ADED 24-05 for full Travel Policy Guidelines). Local programs will be reimbursed mileage for one vehicle per four (4) participants and a second vehicle when more than four (4) attend an approved meeting without advanced written permission from the Director of Adult Education. For 1-day trainings, participants must live or work (whichever is closer) 150 miles or more from Little Rock in order to receive lodging reimbursement for the night before. Total maximum lodging reimbursement per night is \$110 plus tax. Participants must submit an original signed hotel receipt for reimbursement.
