Leveraging AI in Adult Education (AALRC) Session ID: 544748 ■ February 27, 2025

This training is scheduled for February 27, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., at the AALRC. Attendees may valet park in the building parking deck and the AALRC will validate. This full-day professional development session will equip educators with tools to integrate generative AI into teaching. This training is split into two parts. Part 1 introduces AI fundamentals, ethical considerations, and hands-on activities for designing AI-assisted learning assessments. Part 2 focuses on applying instructional strategies with AI, covering prompt writing, lesson design, and using AI to enhance feedback. By the end, participants will have a toolbox of AI-enhanced instructional strategies and a personalized action plan for implementation in their educational settings

Adult education funded participants will be reimbursed according to state travel guidelines (refer to Program Memo ADED 24-05 for full Travel Policy Guidelines). Local programs will be reimbursed mileage for one vehicle per four (4) participants and a second vehicle when more than four (4) attend an approved meeting, without advanced written permission from the Director of Adult Education. For 1-day trainings, participants must live or work (whichever is closer) 150 miles or more from meeting location in order to receive lodging reimbursement for the night before. Total maximum lodging reimbursement per night is \$110 plus tax. Participants must submit an original signed hotel receipt for reimbursement. **Registration is open!
