The workshop is scheduled for Friday, February 21, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Dr. Shelia Wilkerson and Rob Pollan, with the AALRC, are the presenters.

This workshop is designed for employees who have no knowledge of how to use their Shoebox (*esc*Works) or just for those who may need a refresher on how to cancel a registration or how to consolidate Shoebox accounts from past employers. Learn why it is important to modify an existing Shoebox account, rather than create a new one and why Shoebox accounts should ALWAYS list your <u>work</u> email address as the primary email. Information on these topics, as well as hands-on demonstrations on how to register for training sessions, how and when to cancel a registration, how to retrieve a record of trainings attended, how to locate relevant training information (i.e., description, trainers, and zoom link), and how to update your *escWeb* Shoebox account settings, will be covered.

All registrants will receive an email confirmation, generated through *escWeb*, that will provide the zoom login information. Please read the entire email and <u>save the zoom</u> information to your calendar for easy access on the day of the training.
