DRC Offline Digital Testing Application Requirements

The DRC Offline Digital Testing application is designed for digital test assessments. The application can be installed on Windows and run as a server allowing other machines that are connected in the same local area network to connect to it via a Chrome browser. The application uses a local database to store the users and assessments.

Base Hardware Requirements for 100 Concurrent Users

Operating System

- Windows 10 or later.
- Both 32-bit or 64-bit.

Processor

- An Intel Pentium 4 processor or later that's SSE2 capable.
- Both x86 and AMD (x64) binaries are provided for Windows.

Available Memory

- Minimum – 12 GB RAM.
- Recommended – 16 GB RAM or higher.

Available Disk Space

- 16 GB minimum 32-bit or 20 GB 64-bit.

Screen Size – Required – 11" or larger.

Screen Resolution – 1024 x 768 or better.

Network Connection – Wired or wireless network connection – 25 Mbps or better.

Internet – Required for Administrator logins.

Power Supply

- Device plugged into a power supply.
